

Way in relationship with one another and our neighbors that we come to see differently, not the other way around. We often assume that if people just get the right ideas about God, transformation will occur. Yet the Biblical narrative suggests a different pattern, in which people experience an encounter with God that leads them into a practice and discovery through which a right understanding emerges much later.... It is more about relationship, experience, trust, and action—all of which bring about a new way of seeing and interpreting life."

As I think back on July, I cannot help but rejoice in the powerful ways that the Spirit called us to grow in faith together. Living Springs youth and adult

volunteers joined with nearly 120 other folks from Midlands Lutheran congregations to grow together in faith through the annual Graceworks servant week in Columbia: beginning and ending each day with inspiring worship times; sharing in learning events shaped by Vicar Marty and her planning team; reaching out to wounded veterans, to homeless men/women/

children, to children at the Autism Academy & Camp Discovery & Christ Mission & Hannah House; to seniors in adult daycare and assisted living centers; to local law enforcement servants and firefighters; to Meals on Wheels

recipients, and more! We grew in faith together as God's joyful family on LS Night at the Fireflies game, with our LS Disciples of Harmony inspiring the crowd with the National Anthem. We grew in faith together with Rice Estate guests at our LS quarterly supper. We grew in faith together in a visit to experience

worship with our Jewish neighbors. We grew in faith together with college students, offering blessings for our Carl Lowman Memorial Scholarship recipients and our Living Springs Continuing Education grant recipients.

Our Sr. Youth grew in faith together on a truly Spirit-filled summer mystery trip experiencing an amazing outdoor Christian music concert

in Atlanta, cheering on the Braves, having conversations with counter workers at the Varsity restaurant, distributing blessing bags in a Birmingham park, walking the bridge in Selma, waving to passers-by while picnicking in a field on the road to Montgomery, writing Scripture lessons and life

-learning on boots, sharing communion each night in new worship spaces, touching dozens of homeless lives at the massive Gateway Transition Center in Atlanta, growing in our call to be disciples who "do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with God" (Micah 6:8).

We at Living Springs have all grown together in faith this past year with Vicar Marty Wagner and the partnership of theological education we share with our Lutheran seminaries. What a blessing she has been! We are now growing together in faith through the inspiring music brought to us in worship through our new Music/Worship Director, George Donovan, Jr. (If

you haven't been to worship in a while, be sure to come and invite a friend to be able to experience

George's gifts!)

Every day, children are growing together in faith in our excellent preschool and afterschool ministry—plus all the other ministries of grace that occur in this place and in our community through the Spirit's work in you, God's people of Living Springs. I am excited about all the opportunities for growing together in faith that will come in August and the huge Rally Day event on August 28. I am also excited about the new pictorial directory that will help us get to know one another better as fellow disciples. (If you haven't signed up, please do so—it's not about the pictures or our appearance—but about having a directory that

will allow fellow disciples to put faces with names, so that we all may better grow together in faith!) As we move toward the end of summer, may the Spirit speak to our hearts, that we may each more fully know and experience the wonder of what it means to grow together in faith—as disciples of Jesus, walking the Way to be living witnesses to the hope of God's love for this hurting world!

#### **MONTHLY HOPE SUNDAYS**

As we read the Scriptures, we find many difficult situations in which the prophets called for justice, and in which Jesus worked to bring hope and healing. As disciples of Jesus, we are called to carry the torch of hope into these difficult situations of life. The **3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of each month** at Living Springs has been designated as "Hope Sunday." During both worship services, we have a brief, **3-4 minute Awareness Moment** to help us become more aware of the dynamics of particular issues – and there will be a **special prayer** for those affected by that issue. Then, between services, **from 9:30-10:30, there will be an informa-**

**tional session in the fellowship hall** (with guest leader), where we can talk more about the issue and learn about opportunities and resources for hope. Hope Sundays can address any issue in which we have a Spirit-tug to shine Christ's light of hope, including some areas that we often find difficult to talk about. Possibilities include: domestic violence, Alzheimers, bereavement & grief, alcoholism & substance abuse, care for aging parents, human trafficking, homelessness, chronic poverty, veterans support, etc. **August's topic is Human Trafficking Survivors.** If there is a particular hope area in which you feel a Spirit-tug, please pass it along to a member of the Hope Ministries Team, so that we can consider for our planning.

## Here are just a few inspiring examples of the Spirit's work since last council meeting, where we have beheld that light, love an hope in many, many ways:

- The reports on local news about our Lutheran youth Columbia GraceWorks only scratch the surface when it comes to the impact and Spirit-power of those days. 18 agencies and hundreds of lives felt the power of God's light and love through the devoted work of some 80+ Lutheran youth and 40+ adults. Every day, 2 Living Springs' buses & LS drivers (Mike, Bill, Jeff) helped to deliver those disciples into the mission field. Our congregation was responsible for coordinating Meals on Wheels visits, and ministry with disabled veterans at the VA Community Life Center, as well as an afternoon of Cookie Appreciation for the Columbia Police and Fire Depts. Vicar Marty headed up a team of youth which did a wonderful job of planning each day's learning faith experience. The theme for the week was Walking the Way and our youth delved deeper into Romans 12, with a focus on community, unity, humility, trust, and God's reality.
- \* Our LS Mystery Mission Trip was truly an amazing experience one worthy of being paired with those powerful Spirit-filled events of Scripture, where missionaries went out into the world to have their hearts and eyes opened to the power of God's reconciling love unfolding for the world. "Do Justice, Love Kindness, and Walk Humbly with the Lord" (Micah 6:8) provided a backdrop for all the youth shared. In Atlanta, Montgomery & Selma, Birmingham and back in Atlanta, our LS youth and leaders experienced the Spirit, with 4 days of prayer, worship, Scripture, sharing blessing bags, moving out of our comfort zones, meeting people from sister Lutheran congregations, ministering to the homeless, seeing God in ballgame attendants & restaurant servers, and being overwhelmed by the joy of Christ in an outdoor Christian music concert with Hillsong United (and Laura Daigle).
- \* We have felt the presence of the Spirit in our Sunday worship with the arrival of George Donovan as our Director of Music & Worship! What wonderful occasions we shared at the Choir/Worship Team fellowship and his congregational reception!
- \* The Spirit was there in the sounds of songs being sung by our Preschoolers and Adult Choir Members at the Rice Estate traveling hymn-sing and again in our fellowship hall at the quarterly Rice Estate supper.
- There was the amazing night at the Columbia Fireflies Game, with some 65 LS folks enjoying the love of Christian fellowship and the entire ballpark being blessed with the sound of LS' own "Disciples of Harmony." Oh, yes, the Spirit was truly there!

#### 2016-2017 Pictorial Directory


