What a joyful celebration we shared at Rally Day in August, as we kicked off our 2024-25 Faith Formation year—with our theme, "Streams of Light, Shining Together!" In fact, the entire month of August with filled with a lot of celebratory streams of light, all shining together: School Bag Blessing Sunday, School Supply Drive, Youth Shareholders Supper, College Student Blessing & LS Cont. Ed Grants, Lutheran Campus Ministry BBQ, Backpack Ministry Stuff-a-Bus, Lutheran Services Refugee welcome, Justice Month, Christian Assistance Bridge Hope Sunday, Football Ministry kickoff, LS-CDC Staff Training Day, Summer Hymn Sings, "Family Stressors & Resources" Emotional-Mental Wellness... and much more!

We are very excited about our "Streams of Light" **three-sided "trinity" devotional focus water bottles** for each person in the LS community. The idea is to carry or put the water bottle in a prominent place, to be able to see it daily as a reminder of our faith theme: through the waters of Baptismal grace, every one of us is claimed, called, gifted, and empowered to be a living stream of God's light, shining God's grace *together* with all the body of Christ—here at Living Springs, out in our communities & throughout the world! If you don't carry the water bottle, consider putting it on a table near your Bible & daily devotional book (a couple of folks have said they are filling it with water and putting flowers in it!). The hope is that it will not only be a daily reminder for you, but that someone else may see it —and it may spark a conversation about how God calls us all to be streams of light, with all the divergent colors of God's beautiful spectrum, unique & yet shining together like a living rainbow for others, through all the clouds of life.







Throughout 2024-25, we will have a **monthly devotional focus,** with readings from Scripture and Christian history to remind us of ways that God's powerful light has shone through clouds of difficulty, despair, or challenge. Also, we are excited to offer a two-part "Lunch 'n Learn" adult faith milestone after worship on Sept. 15 & 22, focusing on our identity, beliefs, and faith practices as Lutheran Christians. 

STUFF A BUS



In addition to items for our backpack program, we were able to support our partnership with Christian Assistance Bridge (CAB) in Blythewood and donate all the items on their wish list.

I saw God at work thru the Richland 2 students who greeted shoppers, sharing a list filled with items needed to provide a food over the weekend for their fellow students via the backpack program as well as the Christian Assistance Bridge that helps families in crisis in our community.





I saw God at work thru the many shoppers who responded and helped fill a bus with items on the list, in whatever way they were able. All shared God's love of their neighbor with their donation. Two shoppers stood out to me that day. One took the list and then returned and asked, "What do you need the most?" And when we pointed out some of those items, the shopper returned with them. Another shopper returned with a buggy full and said "It took me a while but I found every item on the list! What a blessing to see so many generous shoppers responding to a call to help their neighbors in need.

PALMETTO PLACE / CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

The fourth Thursday of the month, a meal is provided to the residents of Samantha House - not more than ten people. If you would like to contribute an item, we pick a different menu each month.

The 20 lunches for Children's Hospital are prepared by Travis and Melanie Mooney at Carolina Deli - he delivers them on the third Thursday of the month.

Both of these outreach events can be funded monetarily.

Our old-fashioned meatloaf dinner will again be offered to several organizations - Palmetto Place, Children's Hospital, First Responders (sheriff and fire stations), and Keepin' It Real (Pastor Oscar).

<u>Palmetto Place</u> - at this writing we are hoping the youth will visit us for Sunday worship, but if not, we will deliver 20 meals to The Oaks (unaccompanied or homeless youth) and 5 meals to Samantha House (youth who are working to gain self-sustainability and permanent housing).

<u>Children's Hospital</u> - every month you see a post about providing lunch meals to the parents and staff on the 5th floor of Children's Hospital. You can't see the joy or appreciation on the faces that receive these lunches provided by Travis & Melanie Mooney (Carolina Deli), but I hear how much it means to the recipients, especially the notes that our CDC makes and are included in the lunch bag. We are going to deliver40 meals for the parents and all staff members - Ms. Shirley Meyers, Administrative Coordinator is going to come in on her day off so she can see that the meals get distributed.

<u>First Responders</u> - a total of 59 meals will go to surrounding sheriff and fire stations.

<u>Keepin' It Real</u> - during GraceWorks, we had the opportunity to feed and give clothing to the homeless and share the gospel. Pastor Oscar works out of U-Haul storage units close to the downtown area. Keepin' It Real Ministries is dedicated to assisting the homeless and less fortunate on their individual journeys toward recovery, through the stabilizing and lifechanging power of the good news of Jesus Christ. We will deliver 60 meals on Monday 9/9.

We will need hands to assemble the meals after 10:30 worship, transportation to deliver the meals, and people to write notes of encouragement that will go with each meal. Many, many desserts are needed - it doesn't have to be home-baked, but please no runny, gooey items.

The meal will consist of meatloaf, mashed potatoes/gravy, green beans and a dessert. There are signup sheets in the admin building and will be on the welcome table each Sunday. Contact Karen Kranz with questions.

Justice Ministry House Meetings Begin

August was "Justice Month" at LS and we heard stories about why we are involved in justice activities and the joy we have found there. We talked about parents who were role models, early church experiences that made a difference, and own understanding of the scriptural call to do justice (Micah 6:8). The August \$6,000 challenge offering to support MORE Justice is underway, and you can find the August "Journey with Jesus" readings online that highlight Jesus's teaching on justice.

In September our annual Justice Ministry House Meetings begin! We come together in homes to talk about a problem that is making life harder for you, a loved one, a neighbor, or our community. We will listen to one another and together start to discern where God is calling us to work this year.

This is the 8th year of LS Justice Ministry and some of the problems that have surfaced in House Meetings over the years include the need for affordable housing, food insecurity, gun violence in our neighborhoods, and care for those with mental illness. We have worked on all of these issues and made headway in addressing these problems. More than 25 other congregations in Columbia will be participating in House Meetings this month, too. On October 28th we will bring all of these conversations to the Community Problems Assembly and vote on the community problem focus for the year ahead.




Worship Helpers Refresher/ Training Session





Celebrate Your Baptism

Don't forget to check the bulletin to see if we will be celebrating your Baptismal Anniversary during this month's Sunday worship services. Immediately below the Gathering Music, there are printed the names of those who are celebrating a baptismal anniversary *in that week*. When the gathering music begins, individuals can quietly come forward to meet Pastor Eric at the baptismal fountain.
